Tarlabaşı Community Center (TTM) 2019

Tarlabaşı Community Center was established by İstanbul Bilgi University Center for Migration Research in September 2006. Since the day it was founded, TTM has been working to support Tarlabaşı inhabitant's equal access to urban life.

In 2019, we have found asking ourselves and each other, frequently, what kind of Tarlabaşı Community Center we want as a space where peace is restored and no violence is allowed, for Tarlabaşı residents who have been exposed to violence and deprivations.

While looking for the answer to this question, 2019 has been a year in which we tried to build the practices of learning together with children and living together in trust with the openness of the mind and the heart. For this, TTM primarily focused on child safeguarding and has worked for the adaptation and strengthening of children from Turkey and Syria.

We tried to strengthen our organizational structure by redesigning the center's spaces, establishing a demand and feedback mechanism, identifying corporate policy documents and procedures, establishing child safeguarding trainings and volunteer committees.

We have made an effort to regulate the flow of knowledge and experience regarding administrative processes by creating an advisory board accompanying the changes in our board of directors made in the general assembly meeting at the end of 2018.

In the activity report, you can find children's and women's studies and activities for volunteers as well as psycho-social support and institutional activities done by TTM in 2019.

In 2020, we will continue our work hoping for a world free of violence and discrimination.

Children have more time to improve their skills.


They can't buy expensive things but they play hopscotch.

So, how do children feel safe at Tarlabaşı Community Center?

- 1- If they have many teachers with them.
- 2- If the center has sufficient lighting.
- 3- If they are not alone.
- 4- If the windows are closed.
- 5- If volunteer brothers and sisters are around.
- 6- If they get along well with their friends.
- 7- If the people around are smiling.
- 8- If they are listened to.
- 9- If their problems are taken into consideration.
- 10- If they can reach big sister Gökçe when they feel bad.







Blue means "very urgent". Red means "we should go to another room immediately" and Yellow means "I need to play with playdough to be ready to talk". If they don't want to talk, they can leave a note to the "Box of Important Things" next to the entrance door. They can express themselves in any language, whether in writing or with pictures. Only Gökçe can see what's inside the box.

Child safeguarding focal person "Big Sister Gökçe" is chosen by the children. When the person changes, the poster will be updated. All the ideas and descriptions in the poster belong to children



*In Turkey, it is customary to call someone a big sister or a big brother if the person is older than you.

Child Safeguarding Needs Analysis

"Birlikte Güvendeyiz" (We are safe together) project TTM conducted within the scope of a minor grant by Support to Life, aimed at making the center a supporting space, safe and open to the participation of all children. Physical improvements were done in order to make the building child friendly. For this purpose, a needs analysis was done with children.

The needs analysis carried out via games chosen from Terres des Hommes (TDH)'s modules, Talking Map-Footprints and Traffic Lights activities were carried out by the Child Safeguarding Volunteer Committee.

Children's City

The project was carried out in cooperation with International Children's Center (ICC) within the scope of the Mikro-fon grant programme. The project aimed at making the fundamental rights violations experienced by children, aged 8-12 living in Tarlabaşı who are from Turkey or Syria, within the routes they use often or play on, visible through their eyes and steps. It also aimed at being a mediator for sharing the solution suggestions the children developed for equal access to urban life with relevant institutions.

CHILDREN'S STUDIES 2019 Social Circus Workshop

Social circus, which is a learning method aiming at physical and social development using circus arts in disadvantaged groups, is utilized by TTM in workshops done in collaboration with Sirko Fantastiko Initiative. In workshops carried out in closed or open groups, socialization studies are done and circus shows are organized every year.

Social circus workshops were carried out
23 times in 2019, 50 children from Turkey and
44 from Syria have attended.
49% of the attendance was by girls and
51% was by boys.

Art Workshops

Painting and drawing techniques are taught at the art workshops, objects which are old or not in use are transformed to be incorporated into production, children's imagination and cognitive development are supported.

The workshops serve to both improve children's creativity and reinforce group dynamics.

90 children attended art workshops 244 times which were held 23 times in 2019.

Photography Workshop

The children went on neighborhood trips in photography workshops where different subjects and techniques are covered to support children's social and sensory development and artistic production skills. The workshop gives the children the opportunity to see their everyday living space through a different lens.

Play Group

The small room of the center was arranged to accommodate the pilot study of the playgroup in March for children aged 3-6. In September, the place was made child friendly with the changes made within the scope of child safeguarding. The studies continue in line with children's needs in the form of three different sessions per day, with a certain group of beneficiaries.

The play group is supported by a psychological counselor and volunteers accompanying the workshop coordinator.



Discovery Workshop

As part of child participation, TTM is trying to make room for children to build their own workshops. The Discovery Workshop started with the planning of two children who are beneficiaries of TTM and continue with their coordination. Esma and Abdülsamet, who are the coordinators of the workshop, decide each week's activities and invite other children to the workshop.

Cultural and Natural Heritage for Children

WOMEN'S **STUDIES** 2019

Women's **Empowerment Program**

Women's Empowerment Studies conducted in cooperation with ACEV in the past years; aimed at facilitating the developmental follow-up of 3-6 years old children who joined the play group in 2019 and to support their mothers' motherhood experiences. In line with women's needs, the interviews conducted for this purpose by a psychological counselor have, in time, turned into studies based on fundamental women's rights where many issues are shared from sexual health to LGBT+ rights. In 2019, 10 sessions were conducted where each session lasted 60 minutes.

Child Safeguarding Neighborhood Training

11 women living in Tarlabaşı attended the needs analysis conducted in March 2019; 8 women participated in the child safeguarding training held in May 2019. Their demands and needs to feel safer in the neighborhood and about TTM were taken note of and they were informed about child safeguarding.

Beşiktaş Municipality Equality Unit's Women's Health Education

The Women's Health Education Program, organized in collaboration with Beşiktaş Municipality Equality Unit, lasted 13 weeks. Topics such as communication, sexuality, rights, children and adolescents, cleaning, nutrition and birth control methods were discussed in depth. Women were informed about what to do when they need any healthcare or counseling. The program ended in February with the regular participation of 6 women.

100 Women 100 Stories

The field study carried out in 2015-2016, includes 3 women working in TTM and 97 women living in Tarlabaşı, consists of a survey with 82 questions and notes from the interviews conducted during these surveys. Some of the findings of this study were made into a report and made available before the comparative field study, planned to be carried out in 2020.

Play Therapy

Playing is the first language that children know and can express themselves most easily on their journey to adulthood. The studies conducted with children aged 3-6 in TTM in 2019 were planned taking into account the role of playing in the emotional, social, cognitive and physical development of the child.

Play therapy trusts that, on the road to recovery the children know their needs the best and predicts that they demonstrate this through play. In this context, "Experiential Play Therapy" method was used within the scope of psychological support studies conducted with children in TTM.

Self-care

The existence of a traumatic experience in the life of an individual can affect not only the individual who is directly exposed to it, but also the people with whom the individual is in contact with.

In this context, for monitoring and supporting volunteers' physical, psychological and mental wellbeing, in addition to supervision studies, self-care focused individual and group support activities are important for the sustainability of our work with volunteers.



PSYCHO-SOCIAL SUPPORT 2019

Psychological Counseling With Adults

During individual psychotherapy sessions with adults, Solution-Focused Brief
Therapy, Cognitive Behavioral Therapy and EMDR - Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing Therapy were used. 48 sessions were carried out, with 3 adults, one woman and two men, each session lasted 45 minutes.

Psychological Counseling With Children

Individual psychotherapy studies with children were carried out using the Experiential Play Therapy method. In this context, 64 sessions of 45 minutes were conducted with 6 children in 2019. In addition to these sessions 15 monthly parental meetings were held. In the studies carried out with adolescents, Solution-Focused Brief Therapy and Cognitive Behavioral Therapy models were used. A total of 21 sessions were conducted with 2 children, each session lasting 45 minutes. In addition to these sessions, 4 parental meetings were held once a month.

Volunteer Supervisions

As of 2019, supervision studies started with the facilitation of a psychological counselor so that our volunteers can share their experiences of the activities they participate in and together we can find solutions to difficulties they go through. Throughout the year, 3 supervision studies were carried out, with the participation of 15 volunteers.

We talked to families in Tarlabaşı, learned the demands of children and determined our needs. As Tarlabaşı Community Center (TTM), we have established a child safeguarding policy to keep the children safe.

The Child Safeguarding Policy consists of the rules on what we should always strive to do and what we should never do. In addition to this, it determines who will be responsible for children's safety violations.

TTM employees, the board of directors, volunteers and anyone who has the possibility of direct or indirect contact with children is obligated to comply with this policy.

1 TTM COMPONENTS

TTM Components (employees, volunteers, neighborhood residents, parents, board of directors, advisory board), if they witness any violence, suspicion of abuse or child safeguarding policy violation, they have to report the incident (When? Where? What happened? Who were involved?) to the coordinator or child safeguarding focal person in 24 hours.

2 CHILD SAFEGUARDING FOCAL PERSON

In cases related to abuse, neglect or exploitation, Child Safeguaring Focal Person / Coordinator, organizes the information, takes precautions and reports the incident to the Board of Directors or the Ethical Commission.

3 ETHICS COMMISSION

The Ethics Commission conducts and finalizes the investigation process. In order to protect the child, the Ethics Commission takes temporary measures in 48 hours after receiving the notification, until the investigation of the case is complete. The investigation of the incident is concluded within 21 days after receiving the notification.

4 BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The board of directors makes a decision by evaluating the Ethics Commission's investigation report or the notification of the Coordinator / Child Safeguarding Focal Person. This decision may include sanctions such as verbal or written warning or termination of the relationship. The board of directors is obliged to apply to legal processes when necessary.

September 1 Child Safeguarding, Child Participation, Communication Policy Documents, Working Principles, KVKK (Personal Data Protection Authority) Document and Volunteer Duties are prepared. These policy documents were officialized by the board of directors' decision on September 17, 2019.



Institutional **Education Videos**

Institutional training videos were prepared with the support of our Board of Directors and Advisory Board members. The videos produced on child safeguarding with Ebru Ergün, Child Participation with Zeynep Kılıç, Working Principles with Gizem Külekçioğlu and Voluntary Duties with Ceren Suntekin, aimed at making a contribution to the field and to TTM components.



Child Safeguarding Policy Meeting

The training was conducted by Ebru Ergün on September 4, 2019 with the participation of 10 TTM employees and board members and lasted about 3.5 hours. The discussions on borders and responsibilities enabled a deeper focus on the center's policy on child safeguarding.
